



Torre San Marco: Exclusive location on the Garda Lake

Placed on the shore of the Garda Lake, in Gardone Riviera (Brescia), Torre San Marco is a magical place. The intimate and romantic location has a history that makes it the perfect place to hold an event.

BRIFF HISTORY

Torre San Marco (ex Ruhlan Tower) was built as observatory by a German industrialist, Richard Langensiepen, at the beginning of the 1900s.

In the 1950's, Gabriele D'Annunzio bought the Ruhlan Tower. He converted it in an extension of the Vittoriale and modified the style of the structure: from Neo-Gothic to Venetian. This transformation was entrusted to the architect Giancarlo Maroni who also was the designer of the Vittoriale. Gabriele D'Annunzio changed the name of the tower in Tower San Marco.

Torre San Marco was also the secret location where Benito Mussolini and his lover Claretta Petacci used to meet.

In the small basin, the boat M.A.S. (acronym of MEMENTO AUDERE SEMPER= remember always to dare) was often docked. It was the means of transport used for the famous Buccari's joke and, now, it is kept inside the Vittoriale.


